Our consultants collaborate with school teams, students and their families by remote and in-person consultation services.

## How much do CDCI CARES Team services cost?

Consultation and Technical Assistance (TA) services are provided to public schools at no cost. Assessments, evaluations and counseling are provided for a fee of \$140/hr.



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
