

Diapers and Pull-Ups from Medicaid and Dr. Dynasaur

Does your child have a medical need for diapers?

Some children have a medical condition that makes them unable to control urine. The medical term for an inability to control urine is incontinence.

Children who have incontinence, because of a medical condition, need to wear diapers for a short time, or sometimes for the rest of their life.

What will Medicaid and Dr. Dynasaur pay for?

Dr. Dynasaur will pay for diapers, pull-ups or pads for children who have incontinence because of a medical condition. The number per month depends on how old your child is.

- If your child is under age three you must buy the first 150 diapers. If your child has incontinence, because of a medical condition, Dr. Dynasaur will supply up to 150 more diapers each month.
- For children over age three, with incontinence, because of a medical condition, Dr. Dynasaur will supply up to 300 diapers a month.
- For children who are age six or older, Dr. Dynasaur will pay for up to 300 pull-ups, pads or diapers. Children who use pull-ups need to be part of a training program to help them become continent.
- Some children need more than 300 supplies a month. You need to get approval from Dr. Dynasuar to get more than 300 diapers, pads or pull-ups a month.

How do I get diapers?

- 1. Talk to your doctor. Your doctor will help you find out what supplies your child needs.
- 2. Get a prescription for diapers, pull-ups or other incontinence supplies from your doctor.

- 3. The prescription may have your child's main diagnosis, a diagnosis of incontinence, and the amount of supplies for a month. Your doctor will write "diapers" or "pull-ups" on the prescription and may write the name of a brand. Your child may need diapers, pull-ups, pads or a combination of supplies.
- 4. To get approval for more than 300 a month, your doctor will give you a prescription. The pharmacy or store you go to will send a prior authorization form to Dr. Dynasaur to get approval. Once Dr. Dynasaur receives all of the information needed they will make a decision within 3 days.

Where can I buy diapers?

- 1. Take the prescription to a pharmacy or store that can bill Dr. Dynasaur for diapers. Many pharmacies, grocery stores and medical supply stores can bill Dr. Dynasaur.
- 2. If you need help finding a store where you can get diapers from Dr. Dynasaur, call Green Mountain Care Member Services at 1-800-250-8427.
- 3. The pharmacy or store may have to order what you need. You should call ahead to make sure they have what you need.
- 4. The pharmacist or store does not have to give you the brand that is written on the prescription. Dr. Dynasaur pays a set cost for diapers or pull-ups. The store can decide to substitute a generic item, but they are not required to. Talk to the store to make sure you get the right size and type to fit your child.
- 5. As children get older, they grow and may become more active. This can make it hard to find a diaper or pull-up that fits. Talk to your doctor or pharmacist about the best product and size for your child.
