What is I-Team Early Intervention?

We provide services around Vermont at no cost to local Early Intervention teams and families.



We're an interdisciplinary team who provide consultation and training to local teams working with infants and toddlers with complex medical and developmental needs.

- Developmental Education
- Speech Language Pathology
- Physical Therapy
- Occupational Therapy
- Family Resources Consultation

We provide modeling, coaching, brainstorming, and problem-solving.

What kind of support does the Early Intervention team provide?

We collaborate with local providers using email, in-person consultation, phone, and distance technology.

Following all technical assistance visits, we provide a summary outlining recommendations and discussion to the full team.

How does our early intervention process work?

We gather information about your child by facilitating a conversation, during which we learn about skills and needs within the context of daily routines and activities.

Seeking input from all team members, we gain a well-rounded understanding of your child and establish team priorities.

Once we all decide on priorities, our team and the local team together will develop:

- 1. Outcomes identifying objective measures for team support;
- 2. An action plan outlining the ways in which we'll provide support.

Based on these priorities, we provide research-based resources, conduct team-based trainings, and collaborate with local providers.
