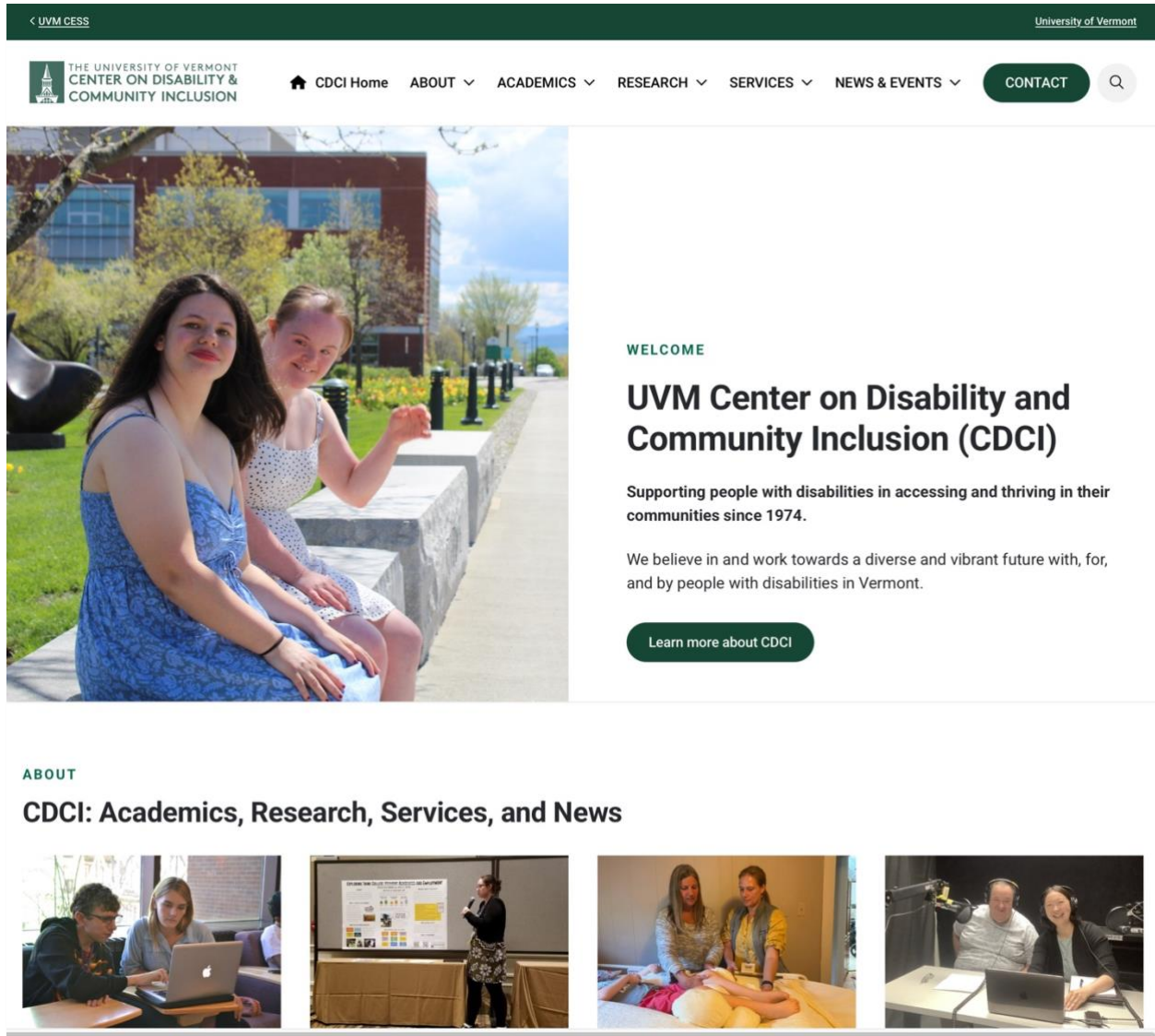


CDCI Website Feedback

CDCI has built a new website. You can find it at go.uvm.edu/cdci.



This website was built by and with people with disabilities, their families, and disability service professionals.

CDCI started with UVM's website design, then made changes based on feedback from CAC members, including:

- More whitespace, less text
- CDCI-specific search button

- Clearly labeled homepage link and icon
- More photos of people with disabilities
- Easy-to-find staff directory
- Easy-to-find podcast links
- Easy-to-find links to CDCI projects

Next, CDCI is going to do two things:

1. We are going to ask 30 people with disability or family members to give us private feedback about the website. They will be paid for their time. We are doing this as a research study because UVM has not done any research on websites and disability. If you want to give private feedback on the website in a separate, paid session, please let Jesse know.

How to Give Feedback on the CDCI Website at the CAC Meeting

4. Do you have any suggestions for how we could improve this website overall?
